FIRST MEETING OF THE ASIA/PACIFIC ICAO FLIGHT PLAN & ATS MESSAGES IMPLEMENTATION TASK FORCE

SUMMARY

The First meeting of the Asia/Pacific ICAO Flight Plan & ATS Messages Implementation Task Force (FPL&AM TF/1) was held from 17 -20 March 2009 at the Asia/Pacific Regional Office. This paper presents an overview of the more significant outcomes of the meeting.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 APANPIRG/19 (September 2008) was of the view that that a full and comprehensive assessment of the implications of the transition to the new Flight Plan and ATS messages formats described in Amendment 1 to the 15th Edition of the PANS-ATM was absolutely necessary. In order to ensure that the matter would be appropriately addressed on a regional basis, APANPIRG/19 adopted the Decision 19/6 establishing a regional Task Force and drafted preliminary Terms of Reference accordingly.

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The First meeting of the Asia/Pacific ICAO Flight Plan & ATS messages Implementation Task Force (FPL&AM TF/1) was held from 17 - 20 March 2009 at the Asia/Pacific Regional Office. Thirty-seven (37) participants from Australia, China, Hong Kong China, India, Japan, Malaysia, New Zealand, Philippines, Republic of Korea, Singapore, Thailand, United States, Viet Nam and IATA attended the meeting.
- 2.2 Outputs from FPL&AM TF/1were many, and included the reviewed TORs, updated PFF and, very importantly, an interim strategy for regional implementation that was ready for review by APANPIRG and the Sub-Groups. The review of Amendment 1 completed by the Task Force had identified a number of matters which would be relayed to ICAOHQ for clarification. Agreement had been reached to conduct a one day seminar as the first day of the next meeting during November 2009 and a training



presentation was available to assist States in briefing colleagues in their home administrations. Details in this respect are contained in the attachments to this paper.
