


# ICAO STRATEGICO OBJECTIVES

  - •Enhance the efficiency of aviation operations


# **UPR** Description

- User Preferred Routes allow aircraft to flight plan the most efficient route for their flight.
  - Unrestricted point to point flight planning
  - Restrictions within different airspace volumes
  - UPRs between two points










# **UPR Trials in the CEP**

#### **UPR Routes Japan – New Zealand**






## Japan - New Zealand UPR Trials

- Paper Trials show potential for large savings
- Oakland, Auckland, Nadi, and Brisbane
   Control Centers can support operational Trials
- Port Moresby will be working with ASA/FAA to be ready to support the trials in the future.
- •UPRs were presented at the IPACG meeting to JCAB.
  - >JCAB can not support UPRs at this time.
