Processing WTC J

SUMMARY

Airways is planning on modifying their oceanic ATM system (OCS) to convert any received FPL or AIDC message for A388 aircraft that contains an incorrect H wake turbulence category (WTC) to the correct ICAO J designator.

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 When the ICAO J superheavy designator was introduced, our domestic ATM was unable to process the new designator and software changes were made that enabled us to modify any received J to an H in our flight data record. These changes are now redundant, and Airways plans to roll them out.

2. **DISCUSSION**

- 2.1 Airways still receives some A388 FPL and AIDC messaging containing H WTC. We plan to introduce software that will modify any A388 FPL or AIDC message containing H WTC to J in our flight data record to ensure that any AIDC message originating from OCS will contain the correct ICAO WTC designator.
- 2.2 Initial co-ordination with some ISPACG ATSP this week indicates that there are still differences in how we handle the J designator.
- 2.3 ISPACG did have an action item on this issue (AI 27-3 from ISPACG/31) but it is now closed and we are unable to find a reference to the closure.
