



Airline update

Covid position and response

- 1 Aug 2022 New Zealand open to fully vaccinated travellers from all countries.
- During July 22, Air New Zealand restarted 14 city-pairs.
- All restarts evaluated using Risk Management processes and full or light readiness checklists due to concerns regarding airport operations, ground handling etc.
- As we stand only pre-covid destination still to restart is Chicago (planned for 30 October)
- New sector Auckland – New York to commence 17 September. Ultra-Long Range operation.

Aircraft changes

- B777-200 fleet of 8 exited our operation.
- New Domestic aircraft delivering with FANS capability. Working with Airways to implement domestic datalink.
- B787-9 & -10 deliveries delayed to start 2023 with Genx engines.

Airspace

- Air New Zealand continues to pursue the allocation of No FIR to appropriate ANSPs to further enable ops in East Pacific. Currently stalled with ICAO due to internal South America issues.
