

Overall PBCS/RNP4 Approved %




March 2023 NOPAC Flights

 - Non-PBCS/RNP4 approved operators may flight plan above or below the R220 requirements or on R580 or south.
- **Routes R591 and G344 Removed but the Waypoints** retained

NOPAC Redesign Phase 2 Non-Approved PBCS/RNP4 Operators

- Aircraft without PBCS/RNP4 approval may flight plan via A590 or south; or
 - Aircraft without PBCS/RNP4 approval may flight plan at FL330 and below or FL410 and above on R220 westbound or R580 eastbound.

NOPAC Redesign Phase 3 Tentatively 2024


