Confirming Current Data Authority (CDA) in NZZO

### **SUMMARY**

Confirmation of CDA entering NZZO airspace is currently achieved by requiring aircraft to send a CPDLC position report. Airways proposes to modify this procedure by using the aircraft response to the latency monitor uplink to confirm CDA.

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Airways proposes to modify our current procedure for confirming CDA.

#### 2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1 The Global Operational Datalink Manual (GOLD) guidance allows three methods for confirming CDA. These include waiting until a downlink message is received from the aircraft or sending an uplink to the aircraft and using the operational response to confirm CDA.
- 2.2 The New Zealand AIP (ENR 1.1 para. 4.3 and 4.4) currently requires aircraft to send a CPDLC position report on entering NZZO. The receipt of the CPDLC position report is used to confirm CDA.
- 2.3 Airways proposes to remove the requirement for a CPDLC position report on entering NZZO and instead use the operational response to the latency monitor uplink to provide the required confirmation.
